class Descriptions



Morning Power Hour: Monday-Friday Mornings 8:00-8:45am. No cost. Receive homework help every morning! This is a safe place for kids who need to come to school early. Even though it is free we need everyone who attends to fill out the registration forms. In Mrs. Everitt's classroom in 3rd grade hall
open GYM: Mornings Tuesday-Friday 8:00 - 8:50am. Learn skills in volley ball, Basketball & Soccer. Plus come learn Yoga, workouts, or even running. (taught by Ms. Darger)

Reading Interventions: (Tues. 1-2 grades, Thurs 3-4 grades, If you have a student who is older that would like to sign up, please sign them up, we will not turn away anyone who wants help reading.) Students have the opportunity to get extra specialized reading help. There is no cost for this club. See attached letter. (Taught by Mrs. Craig)

Pottery Club: (Grades 3-6) students will create several different pottery projects. They will learn how to make a pinch pot, coil pot, and even create a pot on the potter's wheel. Each project will be glazed. (taught by Mr. Craig)

Lego Club: (Grades K-3) create awesome Lego creations and learn valuable engineering skills along the way!

Game Club: (Grades 2-6) Do you love to play games? Do you have the skill to play well? Come learn fun new party games, board games, or sports games.

Lego Robotics Club: (Grades 4-6) come experience the fun of building and programming your own robot with Lego Mindstorms EV3 kits! At the end of each session we have a battle to see if your bot is tough enough. (taught by Mrs. Montoya)

Astronomy: (Grades 4-6) This club is out-of-this world! You will explore astronomy concepts through engaging hands-on activities and take participants on a journey through the universe beyond the solar system. (Taught by Ms. Kenzie)

Arts, Crafts & More Club: (Grades All) Learn all types of Art styles as you create fun, expressive, exciting art projects that spark your inner artist. (Taught by Mrs. Taylor and Mrs. Peay)

Treat Creations Club: (Grades 1-3) Have fun learning how to make fun treats and snacks. You will learn the proper way to handle food. Try new delicious recipes and taste your creations. (Taught by Mrs. Taylor)

Scrapbooking Club: Love to take pictures? Learn to make your pictures pop! Scrapbooking is a fun hobby where you organize your pictures into amazing books you will enjoy for years to come. (taught by Mrs. Boulton)

Painting Club: This club allows kids to experience the creative process and the joy of painting! Now seeking: creative, curious, Big Thinking and Aspiring Artists. (Taught by Mrs. Kesler)

Real Animal Experience Club: In this club you will have a hands-on experience with animals. Each week you will learn about a different animal. Our club leader works at UVU Biology Lab and will be sharing some fun animals she works with. (Taught by Mrs. Cavan)

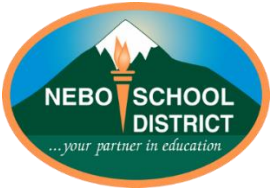
