2. Updates on Safe Walking Routes

-discussed changes to busing next year. There will/have been some new sidewalks put in with the new development

Next school year, there will not be a courtesy bus for students behind the school and to the southwest of the school since sidewalks are now in place and it is no longer a safety hazard for walking. Parents affected by this change have already been notified so they have plenty of time to make the needed adjustments for their children before next fall. Keri will be creating a School Access Route for that area to propose to the city and district in June. Parents will be notified after that approval of the recommended walking route for students.
