## 1. Review & Approve Minutes from October 27, 2021 Meeting

Kristi motioned to approve minutes from the October meeting; Emily seconded the motion.

## 2. Review Data: Reading and Math (Acadience DIBELS & iReady)

See attached Data document image (below)

Notes: BOY = Beginning of the Year, MOY= Middle of Year, EOY= End of Year

-Math data represents grades K-3

-District wide goal is an increase of 1% in each area

-In order to reach the overall 1% growth goal that is being reported to the state for K-3

-Kindergarten needs to maintain proficiency levels from middle of year (MOY) to end of year (EOY)

-Currently across the district we are seeing drops in scores MOY, we are working on avoiding that with current interventions.

-First grade students will increase on benchmark proficiency By 13% from BOY to EOY.

-Second grade students will increase on benchmark proficiency By 1% from BOY to EOY.

-Third grade students will increase on benchmark proficiency By 4% from BOY to EOY.

iReady is used at our school as formative assessment data to track progress throughout the year; Acadience data is used at BOY, MOY, EOY as a summative assessment.

ESSER and technician data is being tracked weekly for progress monitoring.

PAWS (reteach) instruction provides daily reteach instruction in the area of math.

### Other:

-Maggie, inquired as to whether our current safe walking route is being impacted by new construction in the area. Reports from Kristi and Emily indicated that the construction is on the other side of the street. Keri asked that SCC members report any concerns that they see as they are driving the route day to day. Keri will also request the district representative that assists with coordinating safe walking routes visit the area(s) of concern and review the current situation to assess any potential risks.

-Kristi motioned to skip the December meeting; Rio seconded the motion. Our next meeting will be January 19, 2022
