1. Review & Approve Minutes from February Meeting

- a. Emily Giles motioned to approve minutes (typos corrected); Kristi seconded the motion

2. Kristi Openshaw- Report information from Superintendent SCC meeting

- a. Payson H.S. scheduled to be completed by 2025 school year
- b. COVID-19 update; SCC shared gratitude
- c. Current legislation discussed at this meeting
 - i. Bill re: Trust Land Funds that would change decision of spending to the state level; this bill did not pass; decisions will stay at the school level
 - ii. 6% increase for education funding, some will go into rainy day funds. ~ 2 ½ % to the rainy day fund and 3 ½ % increase funding directly to school.
 - iii. Transgender bill to allow transgender girls to play on girl athletic teams: did not pass
 - iv. Teachers submitting lesson plans to parents 30 days in advance: did not pass
 - d. Textbooks fees- legislation previously passed that would not require parents to pay for textbooks; The state will not be funding the textbook fees, individual districts will need to allocate funding from their budgets- this will come into effect in 2023-2024 (primarily impact secondary schools)

3. School Plan for 2022-23

- The plan has been submitted to Nebo School District, for review
- SCC members given a copy of goals and budget

4. Updates to School Access Routes

- Read statement from Santaquin public safety regarding current plans- Currently they do not have plans for a crossing guard/light at 900 S or Highland Dr.
- Sidewalks are not required if there is enough room to walk
- Discussed various options of changing drop off areas, bus drop off, etc.
